Backpacks, Hats and Hoods • Plan for 23/24	15 min	<p>Good number of responses from the backpack survey.</p> <p>If we went with no backpacks, would be ban them for 6-8 all at once? It seems like it would support our health and safety concerns for our students.</p> <p>There's some concerns about passing time.</p> <p>Opportunities to teach strategies for organization /executive functioning/planning (ex: look at your schedule and determine when it would be best to go to your lockers based on where your classes are).</p> <p>May 1<sup>st</sup> we will finalize our plan for backpacks in 23-24</p> <p>Admin is meeting to go through code of conduct – to clear up hats and hoods in the building.</p> <p>Kids with hood passes – don't always know who has a pass and who doesn't</p> <p>Do we allow hats and hoods? Just hats? We will wait until a recommendation comes from the Code of Conduct committee before we make any decisions.</p>
